

## **Local Training Co-Coordinator Role Description**

The main functions of the role are:

### **To liaise:**

- with churches covered by their Area Synod Pastoral Committee on training matters, and maintain an awareness of local training needs.
- on training matters on the Area Synod Pastoral Committee agenda when appropriate, and to look for training implications of Development & Support Committee decisions.
- with the relevant Development and Support Officer to ensure that local training needs are addressed.
- with the local Lay Preaching Representative when appropriate.

### **To promote:**

- training opportunities to churches in their area.
- events on the Synod training calendar.
- the use of TLS Lite in local churches.
- regular Elders' training by churches.
- lifelong learning

### **To deliver training such as:**

- working with the relevant Development and Support Officer in arranging local training events.
- sharing in the delivery of training locally, using materials provided (for example, from "A Course for Elders").
- sharing in the delivery of other material, produced in partnership with the Development and Support Officers, as appropriate.

This is done through regular discussion with the relevant DSO and attendance at Area Synod Pastoral Committee.
