

GOING DEEPER

At the beginning of the film, we see Hiro making some poor choices and Tadashi guiding him towards better ones. Later in the film, we see Hiro beginning to go down the wrong route, seeking revenge. Baymax shows him a video of Tadashi saying "I'm not giving up on you." Read Psalm 32, verse 8. What does it look like to allow God to lead you in life?



When Hiro is feeling lost and alone, and missing his brother, Baymax says to him "Tadashi is here." Think about the difference this made and the impact it had on Hiro's life.

Read Matthew, chapter 28, verse 20 (from "And be sure of this...."). Now read John, chapter 14, verse 26. What difference does having the Holy Spirit (God) make in your life?



In Ephesians, chapter 6, verses 10-18, we read about the Armour of God. Part of the armour is knowing the truth that we belong to God. God is with us and that we can walk the right way in his peace. Baymax and group got an upgrade in their armour. Which bit of your armour needs an upgrade?

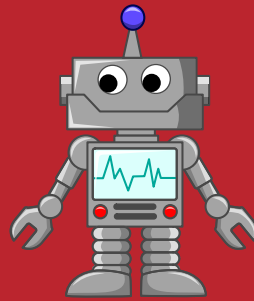


ACTIVITIES

Baymax was programmed to care for people and says to Hiro, "You are my only concern." What do you believe you are 'programmed' to do (what's your purpose)? What 'super powers' (special skills) might you need to develop to help you with this? What do you see as challenges?
